Minutes of the extraordinary parish council meeting held on Wednesday 27 November 2013 in Alrewas Village Hall

2 **Declarations of interest**
No declarations of interest recorded.

3 **Public Participation**
a Mr Dave Crump provided details on the interaction between planning applications and the Neighbourhood Plan.
b A local resident explained that she had vested interest in a small scale potential development in the village. She said the scale of the proposed development 13/011175/FULM made a mockery of village needs and preferences and meant that no further development could be considered for 15 years. Having been asked to consult with the NP team she was concerned that LDC Planning were not treating all applicants in the same way.

Apart from this a resident of Mickleholme Drive expressed concerns about the traffic and asked about public information on this subject.

4 **Advice in respect of Planning Application 13/01175/FULM**
The Council in accordance with its powers under section 137 of the Local Government Act 1972 considered appointing professional consultants to advise on:

- a Flood management – estimated cost £500
- b Traffic management – estimated cost £500
- c General planning considerations – estimated cost £1500

It was **RESOLVED** that professional consultants be appointed to advise on all three matters, such expenditure, in the opinion of the Council, is in the interests of the area or its inhabitants and will benefit them in a manner commensurate with the expenditure.
